This publication applies to all officers and enlisted members of the Air National Guard. It establishes procedures and constitutes authority for the preparation and disposition of separation documents for members of the Air National Guard. It implements AFGPD 36-32. It may be supplemented at any level, but all supplements must be routed to the Office of Primary Responsibility (OPR) listed above for coordination prior to certification and approval. Refer recommended changes and questions about this publication to the OPR listed above using the AF Form 847, *Recommendation for Change of Publication*; route AF Forms 847 from the field through the appropriate chain of command. Requests for waivers must be submitted to the OPR listed above for consideration and approval. Ensure that all records created as a result of processes prescribed in this publication are maintained in accordance with Air Force Instruction 33-322, *Records Management and Information Governance Program*, and disposed of in accordance with Air Force Records Information Management System (AFRIMS) Records Disposition Schedule (RDS). The use of the name or mark of any specific manufacturer, commercial product, commodity, or service in this publication does not imply endorsement by the Air Force. SUMMARY OF CHANGES

This document has been substantially revised and needs to be completely reviewed.

Chapter 1

OVERVIEW

1.1. Overview. The NGB Form 22, *Report of Separation and Record of Service*, should be considered one of the most valuable forms within an ANG member's official record. The NGB Form 22 ([Attachment 2](#)):

1.1.1. Provides separating members with brief, clear records of their military service of the Air National Guard (ANG) at the time of discharge, separation, or retirement.

1.1.2. Reflects a member's service characterization, eligibility for reenlistment, and the reason for separation, discharge, or retirement.

1.1.2.1. Is required for use by separated/discharge members asking for a review of their discharge action or are seeking reentry into one of the branches of the U.S. Armed Forces.

1.1.2.2. Inaccurate information on the NGB Form 22 could result in delay or denial of benefits or the ability to reenter the U.S. Armed Forces.

1.1.3. Provides local civilian and government agencies with authoritative information needed to administer any state/territory laws that may apply to members seeking veteran's benefits.

1.2. The NGB Form 22. The NGB Form 22 is generated by the Air Reserve Personnel Center (ARPC) for all separations and discharges from the ANG with the exception of separations for being a minor in accordance with AFI 36-3209 or deaths. Copies are automatically uploaded into the Automated Records Management System (ARMS) by ARPC and made available to members upon their request.

Chapter 2

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

2.1. National Guard Bureau, Force Management Policy (NGB/A1P).

- 2.1.1. Develops policy and procedural guidance for ANG retirement and separation programs.
- 2.1.2. Coordinates with Headquarters Air Force and ARPC on policy updates.

2.2. Air Reserve Personnel Center (ARPC).

- 2.2.1. Processes requests for and certifies, generates, and distributes official separation/discharge documents for ANG members.
- 2.2.2. Assists members and servicing FSS personnel with the proper processing of requests for separation/discharge documents.
- 2.2.3. Provides guidance to members regarding the processing of their vNGB Form 22 worksheet and official NGB Form 22.
- 2.2.4. Utilizes the vNGB Form 22 worksheet to formulate the official NGB Form 22.
- 2.2.5. Provides administrative changes to the NGB Form 22 as needed by accomplishing a NGB Form 22A ([Attachment 3](#)).

2.3. Force Support Squadron (FSS).

- 2.3.1. Updates final decoration information in MilPDS.
- 2.3.2. Assists members with obtaining source documents when requested.
- 2.3.3. Verifies source document(s) and updates any missing data in MilPDS.

2.4. Commander's Support Staff (CSS).

- 2.4.1. Assists members by providing general guidance and information.
- 2.4.2. Promptly completes a member's final decoration submission to the servicing FSS in myPers for updates to be made in MilPDS.

2.5. ANG Members.

- 2.5.1. Review their official NGB Form 22 upon receipt.
- 2.5.2. Contact ARPC via myPers if errors are discovered on the official NGB Form 22.
- 2.5.3. Provide source documents to ARPC via myPers for updates to missing or inaccurate data (e.g. decoration orders, promotion orders, etc.).
- 2.5.4. Ensure final decoration information is complete and updated in MilPDS, if applicable, before making any request to ARPC to have the information added to the NGB Form 22.

Chapter 3

DISCHARGE CERTIFICATES

3.1. General Instructions. Discharge certificates are generated upon request by the member for applicable separations and discharges from the ANG.

3.2. Types of Discharge Certificates:

3.2.1. NGB Form 438, *Honorable Discharge from the Armed Forces of the United States of America-ANG Certificate*. This certificate is used when a member is separated from the ANG and as a Reserve of the Air Force with an Honorable service characterization ([Attachment 4](#)).

3.2.2. NGB Form 438a, *Honorable Discharge from the Federally Recognized Air National Guard of the United States of America Certificate*. This certificate is used when a member is only separated from the ANG with an Honorable service characterization ([Attachment 5](#)).

3.2.3. NGB Form 439, *General Discharge Under Honorable Conditions form the Armed Forces of the United States of America- ANG Certificate*. This certificate is used when a member is separated from the ANG and as a Reserve of the Air Force with a General (Under Honorable Conditions) service characterization ([Attachment 6](#)).

3.2.4. NGB Form 439a, *General Discharge from the Federally Recognized Air National Guard of the United States of America Certificate*. This certificate is used when a member is separated only from the ANG with a General (Under Honorable Conditions) service characterization ([Attachment 7](#)).

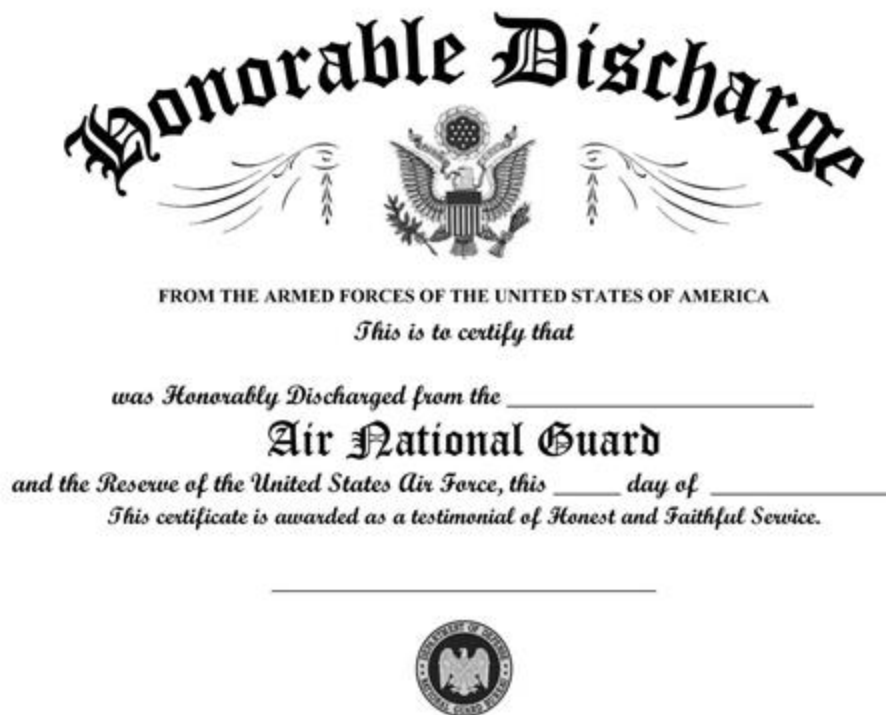

Figure A5.1. Example of NGB Form 438a.



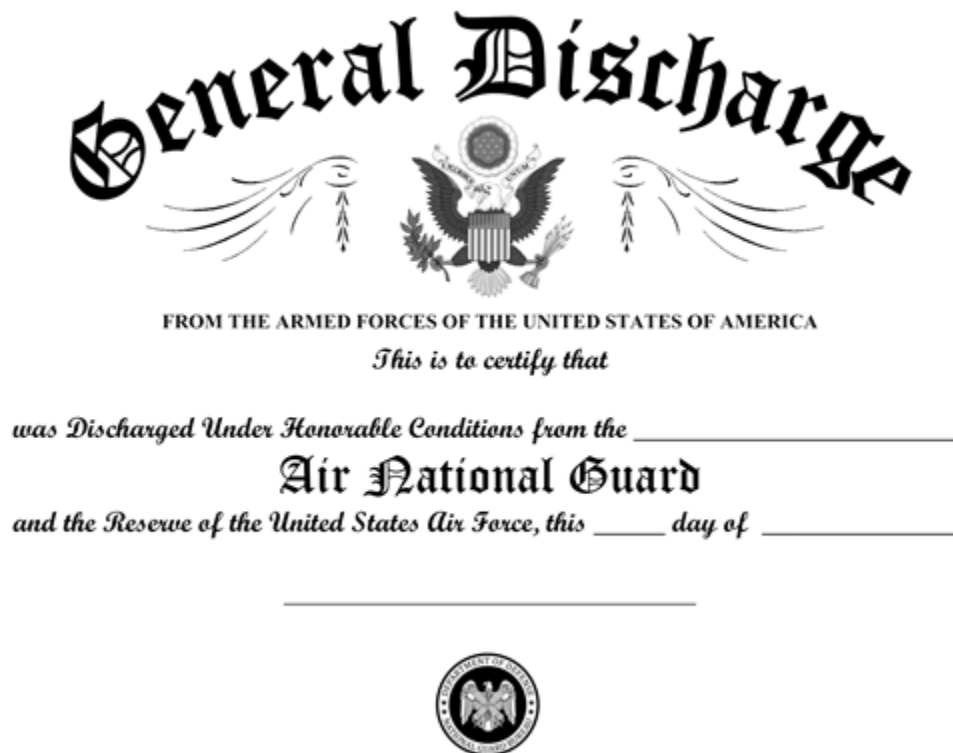
